

Minutes of Bonby Village Hall Committee Meeting held on Monday 22nd February 2010 at 7.30 p.m. in the Village Hall.

Present:

Mrs Owen (Chair), Mrs A Gillman, Mrs S Harriman (Parish Council), Mrs L Cowmeadow and Mrs M Smith.

Apologies were received from Mrs. M Raithby and Mrs. Clark

The Minutes of the Committee Meeting held on 9th November 2009 had been circulated and were signed as a true record, apart from the change of date from 18th January to 22nd February 2010.

Matters arising from the Committee Meeting held on 9th November 2009.

1. Cleaning

The cleaning bill for December and January was £184.

2. Accounts

The accounts for the year ending 31st December are complete apart from the interest on the Nottingham Building Society Account, which is due on the 31st March 2010. Mrs Cowmeadow reported that rental income for the year was £5,170 with outgoings of £4,540.98. The curtain fund now stands at £840. The W.I. have organised a visit to the Skopos Mills factory near Batley to look at materials in March. The curtains need to be flame retardant and the poles need replacing. The existing ones have been in place for over 20 years. After discussion it was agreed to approach the Parish Council for a donation of £350 towards the cost of the curtains, poles etc. We would like to get the curtains replaced as soon as possible as they do detract from the appearance of the Hall.

3. Bookings

Bookings continue to be fairly static.

4. Pre-School

There was no report available from Pre-School but apparently there has been an issue with a shortage of toilet rolls. Mrs Owen will attend to this.

5. Correspondence

Mrs Cowmeadow had received an e-mail from Bonby Parish Council regarding the Bonby Community Emergency Plan. It was agreed that we should invite the clerk, Mrs J Brown, to attend a meeting of the W.I. for a '10 minute' slot to talk about this plan as it would reach a much wider audience than the Village Hall Committee and most of the committee are also W.I. members
